Rules and Regulations

- TEAM FEES: All teams will pay the registration fee in the amount of \$75.00 per team in the form of a check/money order payable to any Hooping 4 Henderson committee member or via Cash App to \$tashnacole or PayPal to <u>latasha.williams09@yahoo.com</u> in order to participate in the tournament. Registration forms and fees are due by October 6th, 2023 and are non-refundable.
- 2. TEAM COMPOSITION: Each team must have at least 7 players and no more than 10. All players must be at least 18 years of age and out of high school (i.e. not a student in high school at the time of the tournament). If a player is not on your original roster turned in by October 6th, 2023, that player will not be allowed to participate unless a \$10 late roster change fee is paid. Any additions or changes to your roster on game day must be approved no later than 30 minutes prior to your 1st game and will also be subject to the \$10 late roster change fee.

No team player changes will be granted to any team after the start of your 1st game.

- 3. **TEAM DRESS CODE:** Each team should wear one specific color; all players should be in easily identifiable uniforms with numbers visible on shirts/jerseys.
- 4. **TEAM ARRIVAL:** Each team must be present at least 30 minutes before the beginning of its scheduled game. Late teams will forfeit their tournament spot. If at least 7 players from a team are not present to start the game, that team will forfeit that game.
- 5. **GAME PLAY:** All usual basketball rules apply. Each game will consist of (2) 8-minute quarters and a five-minute halftime break. In the event of a tie at the end of the regulation period, a 2-minute overtime period will be played. During regulation game play, each team is allotted (2) 1-minute timeouts and (2) 30-second timeouts. During overtime game play, each team is allotted (1) 30-second timeout.
- 6. **PLAYER BEHAVIOR:** All players must be respectful of themselves, their teammates, other players/coaches in the tournament, referees, spectators, and any others in attendance by refraining from unnecessary profanity and other vulgarities. Violators will be ejected NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - a. If a player is unruly or disrespectful to the referees, opponents, or Hooping 4 Henderson Committee members, 1st offense: Warning, 2nd Offense: Team removed from the tournament NOREFUNDS.

Please ensure that each player on the team is aware of and agrees to abide by all rules set forth here.
